If you are interested in renting from Bruce Cohen, I would highly advise it, particularly if you are a mature adult who likes to have open communication with your landlord. Bruce will leave you totally alone if you have no needs from him, and he will quickly respond if you do have needs.

He is knowledgeable about many things and does almost all his own work, so you are not bothered by contractors coming in if you need to schedule for repairs.

He is a gem with your pets (especially cats, which is what we had). He always looked out for them and made sure they were safe. (I think he is a cat whisperer!).

One of the things we loved most about Bruce was his "clear communication". It is not only his motto; he really lives up to it. He clearly communicates about what he will be doing and when he will be doing it, and he always works with your schedule and what is good for you.

We have rented seven places in the Boulder/Erie area, and Bruce is by far the pick of the crop in our landlord experiences. In our lifetimes, we have rented around 40 places, and Bruce is the first and only landlord that made an appointment to sit down and talk to us when we gave our notice for early termination of our lease because we were buying our own home. He was fair in his approach to what early termination meant and he genuinely cared about what was going on for us.
